Dear Representative Pommer:

This letter is in response to the Legislative Request for Information 18 to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing (Department) which states:

Department of Health Care Policy and Financing, Information Technology Contracts and Projects, Information Technology Contracts -- The Department is requested to submit updated implementation cost estimates for Senate Bill 08-006 if the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services approve a state plan amendment to suspend Medicaid eligibility, rather than eliminate eligibility, for confined persons during fiscal year 2009-10.

At this time the Department cannot submit an updated implementation cost estimate for Senate Bill 08-006 since the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) has not approved a state plan amendment to suspend Medicaid eligibility, rather than eliminate eligibility, for confined persons. The Department submitted a proposed policy to implement Senate Bill 08-006 to CMS on May 28, 2009 and held a stakeholder meeting, which CMS staff attended, on August 11, 2009. CMS has not formally responded to the Department's proposed policy. Informal conversations with CMS staff suggest they will not approve our proposed policy since Colorado Medicaid does not have an eligibility category to cover adults without dependent children and therefore there is little opportunity for the Department to actually "suspend" Medicaid eligibility for a majority of the Medicaid population. In reality, the only people who could have their Medicaid eligibility suspended while incarcerated are pregnant females. The Department continues to work with CMS and should have a decision or an alternative proposal in Spring 2010.
