FY 2008-09 Higher Education General Fund Reduction - S-2

Proposal:

The Department has four state-funded sections in the Long Bill: allocations to the College Opportunity Fund Program (COF stipends and fee for service contracts), the state's financial aid programs, the appropriation to the local district colleges, and the appropriation to the area vocational schools. Because FY 2008-09 is already underway, the Department does not believe it is prudent to reduce financial aid or COF stipend appropriations because these funds have already been provided to students or on behalf of students. Further, it would be administratively difficult to reduce the amount of the COF stipend per credit hour even though doing so is allowed in Section 23-18-202 (4) (a and b), C.R.S. (2008).

The Department of Higher Education proposes a \$30,000,000 General Fund reduction in FY 2008-09, with the majority of the reduction to be taken from the fee for service portion of each governing board's allocation, with the remaining reduction taken from the local district colleges and the area vocational schools, neither of which enter into a fee for service contract with the Department. These cuts are requested to be made proportionately to the manner in which new money was allocated in the FY 2008-09 Long Bill (H.B.08-1375) as shown in the *Assumptions and Tables to Show Calculations* section below.

The proposal to reduce the General Fund budget in FY 2008-09 is consistent with how General Fund was allocated during the appropriations process last year (growth from FY 2007-08 to FY 2008-09).

Summary of Request:

- Consistent and proportionate with the method used to allocate General Fund in the FY 2008-09 Long Bill.
- Cutting the fee-for-service portion of governing board allocations is administratively less burdensome
 than reducing the COF stipend amount per student and can be done through amendments to the fee for
 service contracts and adjustments to remaining monthly payments. Only the Community Colleges
 contract would require a "return of funds" because this contract is paid out in one lump sum at the
 beginning of the fiscal year.
- Financial aid grants which have already been calculated and awarded for the fiscal year are not rescinded in this request, ensuring students with documented need continue to receive the aid for which they are eligible in FY 2008-09.

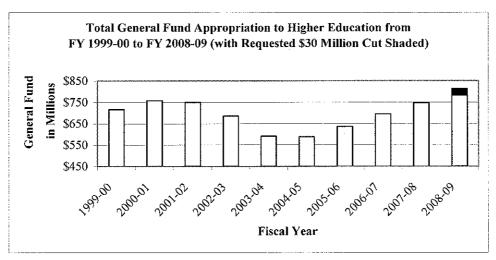
