Task Report

Task #I - The Program

A. Professional services were provided to the State of Colorado for the administration of the Colorado Solar Rebate Program from June 1, 1998 through December 31, 1999. During this period rebate applications, instructions, and procedures were developed in concert with the OEMC (samples attached) meeting the equipment requirements as outlined in the contract.

B. CoSEIA provided program administration for the Colorado Solar Rebate Program. During the period of the contract CoSEIA promoted the program to its membership and the general public. The means of promotion included but was not limited to: o Notices to the public and information distributed at the 1998 and 1999 Denver Parade of Homes o Notices distributed at Western Slope Renewable Energy Fairs in 1998 and 1999 Information distributed at the 1998 ASES Solar Homes Tour for Colorado o Information on the CoSEIA web site o Notices to the CoSEIA members through the Association's newsletter, faxes, email and specific mailings An exhibit booth with member involvement in the 1998 Spring Home and Garden Show o Involvement with CRES and their public programs and PV Referral Phone line o Marketing done by individual members of CoSEIA Colorado Public Service Company did several "bill stuffers" on the rebate program

Program document were developed for the program including the rebate application with instructions and a follow-up site inspection procedure using the completed rebate application for verification. There were 13 system inspections conducted during the contract period. Only one required modification to the system, which was corrected and received final approval from CoSEIA.

The overall evaluation of the program is still in process. CoSEIA will be contacting a random selection of contractors who worked on rebated systems, a random selection of consumers who received a rebate. The evaluation will include the overall satisfaction with the program, suggestions for future improvement. Some of this task has been completed and correspondence recommending continuation of the program has been directly sent to the OEMC by several independent sources. The overall success of the program is shown in the numbers. A total of 132 solar systems were installed between June 1, 1998 and December 31, 1999. Of these systems 108 were grid-tied and off-grid Photovoltaic systems totaling \$200,977.14 in rebates; 10 were Solar Water/Radiant Floor systems total \$24,335.79 in rebates; and 14 Solar Water system totaling

\$14,687.07 in rebates. At the close of the program, at the point the funds were extinguished there were 74 incomplete rebate applications on file with the CoSEIA office. (report attached)

Task #2 - Reports

A. Quarterly status reports where submitted regularly to the OEMC office, which contained up to date statistical information on the number of rebates and their dollar value issued to prior to the date of the report.

B. The final report for this project is this report with an anticipated addendum to follow with the results of additional evaluation findings. CoSEIA Project Completion Customer Satisfaction Survey as of August 1, 2000

At the conclusion of the Colorado Solar Rebate Project a survey of 51 of the 132 consumers (39%) who purchased solar systems and received a rebate were served via phone. Of those individuals contacted the satisfaction rate was 100 % . Each consumer was very satisfied with the rebate payment process, the speed at which the rebate was processed once it was received by CoSEIA's office, and the dollar value of the rebate. None of the individuals contacted expressed any concerns with the program. The comment, "We are so glad to have gotten this rebate, but we would have still proceeded with our solar installation if it was not available" was echoed by 44 % of those consumers contacted in the survey. The other 56 % indicated that the fact the rebate was available was an important aspect in the decision making process to install a solar system on their residence. Many stated, "we would have probably installed a smaller system if it wasn't for the possibility of a rebate".

Of those consumers contacted during the survey 41 received rebates for a photovoltaic installation, 6 had a solar hot water system installed, and one received a solar radiant flooring system.

All of the consumers felt that it was a good program and that if it were continued more residents of Colorado would participate.

Since the conclusion of the program, the CoSEIA office has received, on average, two or three phone calls a month regarding the rebate program. Callers are disappointed when told that the project was terminated at the end of 1999. All of those calls asking if the project will be revitalized have been informed to the negative.

CoSEIA Project Completion Customer Satisfaction Survey as of August 1, 2000

At the conclusion of the Colorado Solar Rebate Project a survey of 51 of the 132 consumers (39 %) who purchased solar systems and received a rebate were served via phone. Of those individuals contacted the satisfaction rate was 100 %. Each consumer was very satisfied with the rebate payment process, the speed at which the rebate was processed once it was received by CoSEIA's office, and the dollar value of the rebate. None of the individuals contacted expressed any concerns with the program. The comment, "We are so glad to have gotten this rebate, but we would have still proceeded with our solar installation if it was not available" was echoed by 44 % of those consumers contacted in the survey. The other 56 % indicated that the fact the rebate was available was an important aspect in the decision making process to install a solar system on their residence. Many stated, "we would have probably installed a smaller system if it wasn't for the possibility of a rebate".

Of those consumers contacted during the survey 41 received rebates for a photovoltaic installation, 6 had a solar hot water system installed, and one received a solar radiant flooring system.

All of the consumers felt that it was a good program and that if it were continued more residents of Colorado would participate.

Since the conclusion of the program, the CoSEIA office has received, on average, two or three phone calls a month regarding the rebate program. Callers are disappointed when told that the project was terminated at the end of 1999. All of those calls asking if the project will be revitalized have been informed to the negative.
