WHAT IS THE CITIZENS' ADVOCATE CORPS?

The Citizens' Advocate Corps assists Colorado citizens with state government issues and concerns. The Advocates serve as special representatives to agencies in state government to assist citizens in their interaction with state agencies.

In an effort to create and maintain a state government that takes a hands-on approach to constituents cases, the Citizens Advocate Corps will provide citizens with a clear and direct method of registering and resolving their complaints and concerns with state agencies.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

- Q. Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps assist with Child Support Enforcement problems? A. Yes. The Citizen's Advocate Corps accepts written complaints about Child Support Enforcement and the Family Support Registry. All complaints are referred to the Department of Human Services. For assistance with child support issues, call (303) 866-4300 or visit the agency's website at www.childsupport.state.co.us.
- **Q.** Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps help with Driver's License problems? **A.** Yes. The Citizen's Advocate Corps accepts written complaints about the Division of Motor Vehicles. All cases are referred to Department of Revenue for assistance at 303-866-4622 or visit: www.revenue.state.co.us
- Q. Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps accept complaints about Colorado Motorist Insurance Identification Program or Explore Information Services?
- **A.** Yes. The Citizen's Advocate Corps accepts written complaints about the Colorado Motorist Insurance Identification Program and Explore Information Services. All cases are referred to Department of Revenue for assistance at 303-866-4622 or visit: www.colorado.gov/driveinsured
- **Q, Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps assist with Local Government issues? A.** No. Colorado is a "local control" state. Efforts to address local government issues must be handled at the city or county level. It is best to work through the appropriate department or with the officials in your city or county.
- Q. Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps accept Police Department or Sheriff's Office complaints?
- **A.** No. Complaints concerning law enforcement must be initiated through the internal affairs investigative process in the respective city or county office.
- Q. Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps accept complaints against a Federal Agency? A. No. The Governor does not have jurisdiction over federal matters. Federal agency complaints, including Social Security, Immigration & Naturalization Services, Veterans Administration, Medicare, and the Military are accepted by federal offices. Please contact your U.S Senator or Congressman or the appropriate federal department or agency.
- **Q. Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps accept complaints about courts, judges, or attorneys? A.** No. The Governor's Office cannot intervene in court cases, overturn decisions made by judges or offer legal advice. For legal advice, assistance, or review, you may contact Colorado Legal Services at 303-837-1313.
- **Q.** Does the Citizens' Advocate Corps assist with Child Custody cases? **A.** No. The Governor has no jurisdiction over individual court cases, including child custody. Custody decisions are made in a court of law and must be handled through the judicial process. If you have concerns about a Guardian Ad Litem, you may contact the Office of the Child Representative at 303-860-1517. You may also contact the Office of Consumer Relations, Department of Human Services at 303-866-5825 for possible assistance.

Q. Does the Citizen's Advocate Corp accept probation or probation officer complaints?

A. No, these complaints are addressed by the Chief Probation Officer of the district the probation is registered.

Q. When should the Colorado Department of Human Services (CDHS) Customer Service Hotline be utilized?

A. Although CDHS benefits and services are provided at the local service facility or county office, the CDHS Hotline is used to gain more information or to file a complaint regarding any service concerns.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

The 1-800 numbers and the metro local numbers operate from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

*TDD or TTY numbers will access a telephone device for the deaf.

The State of Colorado has a national number to access relay services from anywhere in the United States. This abbreviated dialing number is 711.

Relay Colorado provides accessibility to people who are deaf, hearing impaired or speech disabled. Specially trained relay agents complete all calls and stay on-line to relay messages between the parties, either electronically over a teletypewriter (TTY), or verbally to hearing parties.
