The basic strategy of School-to-Career is to ensure that school curricula is relevant to careers and that students understand the link between education and their career opportunities and options.

The Colorado School-to-Career Partnership is full of exciting opportunities, such as:

**Elementary School**: Children will begin to be exposed to a wide range of career possibilities. They will begin to learn how to be a good worker and the importance of completing tasks, following directions and relating to others

**Middle School**: Youth will begin to explore different careers and further develop good work-place habits.

**High School**: Students will continue to work on discovering career options and develop good work-place habits, as well as, obtain actual job-site experience. Some will be able to choose and select career options best suited to their skills, talents and abilities; they will also realize that further education is critical to their career path.


