POLAND -

(1) PRELIMINARY COMMENTARY ON FULFILLMENT OF POLISH ECONOMIC PLAN FOR 1959, ACKNOWLEDGING THAT FULL TEXT OF COMMUNIQUE IS NOT YET AVAILABLE. COMMENTARY EMPHASIZES DISTURBING INCREASE OF FOREIGN TRADE DEFICIT CAUSED BY FALL OF WORLD COAL PRICES AND POLAND'S INABILITY TO COMPETE IN TRADE OF INDUSTRIAL GOODS: COMMENTARY ADVOCATES EXPORT OF FOLKLORE ART, PRODUCTS OF HANDICRAFTS, AND FARM COMMODITIES. COMMENTARY CONCLUDES THAT NO SOURCE OF FOREIGN CURRENCY SHOULD BE DISREGARDED IN LIGHT OF NONFULFILLMENT OF HOUS-ING CONSTRUCTION PLAN AND SLOW-DOWN OF CONSUMERS' GOODS PRO-DUCTION. (2) REPORT BY VISITING BRITISH SCIENTIST DESCRIBING POLISH SCIENCE. (3) PANORAMA ITEM ON BOLESLAW PIASECKI'S METHOD OF DISPOSING OF HIS POLITICAL OPPONENETS (BASED ON STEHLE ARTICLE IN FRANKFURTER ALLGEMEINE ZEITUNG). (4) COMMENTARY ON SOVIET BOOK EXHIBITION IN LONDON, STRESSING WITHDRAWAL OF BOOKS BY WESTERN AUTHORS.
