USE OF FORCE AND PLEDGE TO RESPECT EACH OTHER TERRITORIAL  
INTEGRITY, AMOUNTS IN PRACTICE TO A TACIT RECOGNITION OF THE  
PRESENT BORDER  
ON THE ODER-NEISSE LINE!"  
TWO: SULZBERGER IN HIS COMMENTARY SAYS THAT..." SO MANY
