


**MOTOR VEHICLE E-CODE DECISION TREE (PAGE 1)**

**Is a motor vehicle\* involved?**



**Did the event involve a motor vehicle colliding with a train?**

If Yes, use E810

**Did the event involve a motor vehicle colliding with a non-motorized vehicle such as a bicycle, a person riding an animal, an animal-drawn vehicle, or a streetcar?**

If Yes, use E813

**Did the event involve a motor vehicle colliding with a pedestrian (includes people using rollerskates, non-motorized scooters, skateboards, skis, non-motorized wheelchairs)?**

If Yes, use E814

**Did the event involve a single motor vehicle?**

Did the motor vehicle collide with something on the highway such as an abutment, animal, guardrail, boundary fence, median, other object, etc. (anything other than another motor vehicle)? If Yes, use E815

Did the motor vehicle lose control or rollover (didn't hit anything)? If Yes, use E816

Did someone get hurt while trying to get into or out of the motor vehicle while it was on a street, highway or public roadway? If Yes, use E817

Did the event involve some other non-collision scenario (being accidentally pushed from a moving vehicle, being hit by an object thrown in to or on a moving motor vehicle, a fire starting in a moving motor vehicle, etc.)? If Yes, use E818


If the details of the incident are unknown, use E819

**Did the event involve two or more motor vehicles?**

Did one motor vehicle leave the roadway, come back on to the roadway and then strike another moving motor vehicle? If Yes, use E811

For all other events that do not involve re-entry but do involve a collision between two motor vehicles (head-on, rear-end, T-bone, hitting a parked car), use E812

\*A motor vehicle is any mechanically or electrically powered device, not operated on rails, upon which any person or property can be transported upon a highway. Includes automobile, bus, truck, motorcycle, motorized bicycle (moped) or motorized scooter, motorized wheelchair, trolley not on rails, van, off-road vehicle, ATV, snowmobile, tank, etc.

**MOTOR VEHICLE E-CODE DECISION TREE (PAGE 2)**

Reminder: For E810-E819 and E820-E825 codes, please be sure to include the 4<sup>th</sup> digit to identify the injured person:

| .0 = Driver of motor vehicle other than motorcycle      | .5 = Rider of animal; occupant of an animal-drawn vehicle |
| .1 = Passenger in a motor vehicle other than motorcycle | .6 = Pedal cyclist  |
| .2 = Motorcyclist                                       | .7 = Pedestrian   |
| .3 = Passenger on a motor cycle                         | .8 = Other specified person                               |
| .4 = Occupant of streetcar                              | .9 = Unspecified person                                   |


On or from <b>stairs or steps</b>	E880
Escalator	E880.0
On or from sidewalk curb	E880.1
Other stairs or steps	E880.9
<b>On or from ladders/scaffolding</b>	E881
Fall from ladder	E881.0
Fall from scaffolding	E881.1
<b>From or out of a building or other structure</b>	E882
Includes fall from balcony, bridge, building, roof, flagpole, tower, wall, window, etc.	
Fall resulting from the collapse of a building or structure	E916
Fall or jump from a burning building	E890.8, E891.8

<b>Into hole or other opening in a surface</b>	E883
Includes fall into a cavity, dock, hole, pit, quarry, shaft, tank, well, etc.	
Injury from diving or jumping into water (swimming pool, pond, lake) and hitting bottom, side or water surface	E883.0
Fall into a well	E883.1
Fall into storm drain or manhole	E883.2
Fall into other hole or other opening in surface	E883.9
<b>Other fall from one level to another</b>	E884
Fall from playground equipment	E884.0
Fall from cliff	E884.1
Fall from chair	E884.2
Fall from wheelchair	E884.3
Fall from bed	E884.4
Fall from other furniture	E884.5
Fall from commode/toilet	E884.6
Other fall from one level to another (fall from tree, fall from embankment, fall from stationary vehicle, fall on a trampoline, etc.)	E884.9


<b>Fall on same level from slipping, tripping, or stumbling</b>	E885
Fall from non-motorized scooter	E885.0
Fall from roller skates	E885.1
Fall from skateboard	E885.2
Fall from skis	E885.3
Fall from snowboard	E885.4
Fall from other slipping, tripping or stumbling (including falls on a moving sidewalk, fall on ice, fall on carpet, etc.)	E885.9
<b>Other or unspecified fall</b>	E888
Other fall	E888.8
Unspecified fall	E888.9
