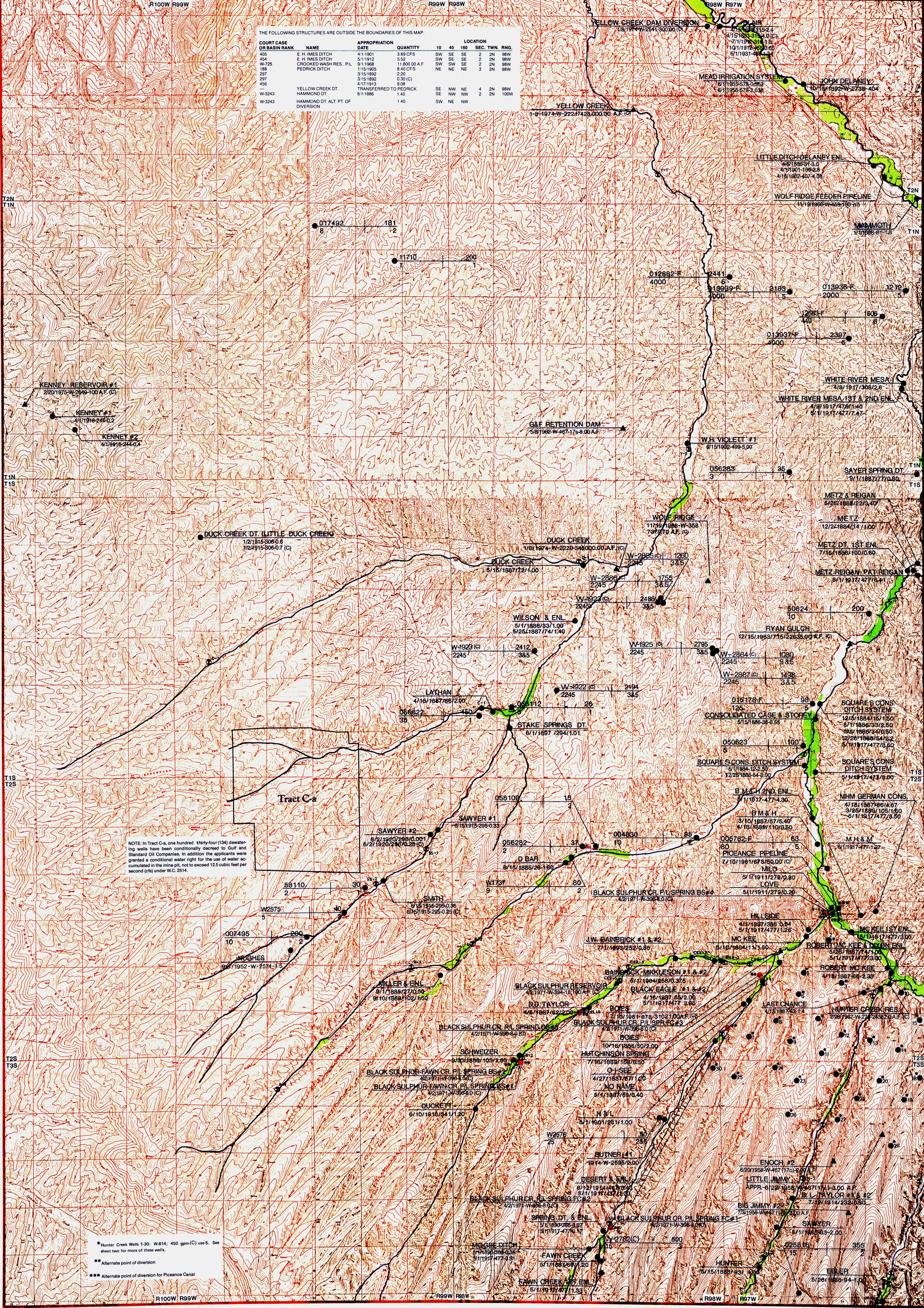

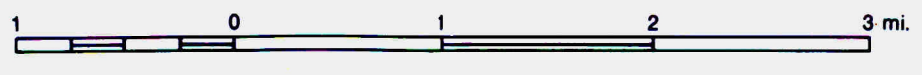
WATER RIGHTS INVENTORY MAP
