#### Introduction

The 2002 Colorado County Budget Comparison Report was produced as a financial reference tool and, specifically, to assist Colorado counties in preparing their 2003 budgets. The report provides a variety of comparative data that counties may find useful for evaluating their budgets. Data are provided for Colorado's fifty-two small to medium size counties, which are aligned geographically in the report according to CCI (Colorado Counties, Inc.) regions. (The eleven largest counties in the state jointly produce an annual budget comparison report of their own.)

Due care and caution have been utilized in the preparation of this report, and the information contained within has been gathered from sources considered to be accurate and reliable. Nonetheless, both human and mechanical errors are inherently possible in a report of this type. Additionally, data may be missing due to survey non-response associated with the 2002 Survey of County Budgets, which was mailed to counties in March of 2002, or due to information not reported in a particular county budget. Missing data is indicated in the report by an asterisk (\*) in the affected fields.

Please bear in mind that comparing budgetary figures across counties may involve comparisons that are not "apples-to-apples" comparisons. It is possible, for example, that similarly named funds or departments from different counties may be comprised of sets of expenditure items that are not identical. Please contact the division to learn more about obtaining line item detail for budgetary comparisons.

The "Highlights" section of this year's report, specifically the "2002 Budget Summary for Selected Funds" table, uses aggregate statistics and medians to describe certain budgetary trends. Both types of statistics, for example, are used to describe percent changes between proposed general fund expenditures for 2002 and estimated general fund expenditures for 2001. To calculate the aggregate percent change between 2001 and 2002, the estimated 2001 expenditures are summed over all 52 counties, and the proposed 2002 expenditures are summed over all 52 counties. The percent change between the 2001 sum and the 2002 sum is the "aggregate percent change." To calculate the median percent change, the percent difference between estimated and proposed general fund expenditures must first be calculated for each individual county, yielding 52 individual percent changes. The "median percent change" is the point at which half (26) of the individual percent changes fall above and half (26) fall below. The median percent change was introduced in the 2001 report because, in some cases, the aggregate percent change was being skewed by significant changes reported by the larger counties in the report.

The 2002 Colorado County Budget Comparison Report introduces additional changes over previous reports. First, line items described as "capital outlay" and "debt service," including "principal," "interest," and "lease payments," have been subtracted from budgeted and estimated fund expenditures and reported under separate headings. This change was implemented in order to help facilitate "apples-to-apples" comparisons between funds from different counties. Second, an attempt was made to estimate "Total Operating Expenditures" for the general government activities of each county. This was accomplished by reporting selected enterprise-type activities, including hospital, airport, ambulance, correctional facilities, mass transit, internal services, and water and sanitation services, separately from functions that are more typically treated as general government activities. The enterprise-type activities are presented in the last section of the report.



Pct. Change Between Proposed Total County Expenditures and Previous Year Total Estimated Expenditures (52 Counties)




Aggregated Expenditures for Total Budget & Selected Funds (52 Counties)

# Pct. Change in County Expenditures Pct. Change in Proposed 2002 Expenditures vs. Estimated 2001 Expenditures




Aggregate Per Capita Expenditures for 2002 Total Budget & Selected Funds (52 Counties)


Aggregate Per Capita Expenditures for Budget Year 2002 (52 Counties)

#### Pct. Change in General Fund Expenditures


Aggregate Pct. Change in Proposed 2002 Expenditures vs. Estimated 2001 Expenditures (52 Counties)


Aggregated Revenues for Total Budget & Selected Sources (52 Counties)






#### **Pct. Change in County Revenues**
