ANATOMY OF A MAIN STREET BUILDING

Cornice/Parapet - visual element completes the top of the façade.

Window Hood/Header - projecting member that is both structural and decorative.

Sash - frame filled with glass. May be operable or fixed.

Sill - horizontal member immediately below the window assembly.

Lintel - structural member above a storefront that supports the wall above.


Transom - upper window in a storefront assembly. May be operable or fixed. May have clear or patterned glass.

Display Window - main area of clear glass for merchandising arrangements.

Pilaster - structural column projecting from the wall.

Bulkhead - the area between the sidewalk and display window.

Column - vertical structural member.
