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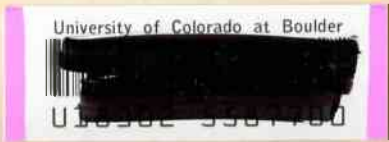

REPORT OF THE Board of Capitol Managers OF THE State of Colorado

Denver, Colorado, December, 1, 1908.

To the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

In compliance with section 7 of an act of the General Assembly of the State of Colorado, entitled, "An Act to Provide for the Erection and Completion of a State Capitol Building at the City of Denver, and Creating a Board of Management and Supervision," approved April 1, 1889, the Board herewith respectfully presents the following report of its acts and doings for the years 1907 and 1908.

The present membership of the board is the same as during the last biennial term, except that Hon. F. J. Chamberlin, whose resignation was accepted June 28th, 1907, was replaced by the appointment of Mr. James Williams.

The routine business of the board is a matter of record, and is open to the investigation of any interested citizen. While the details of their management are of little interest to the Assembly or to the general public, the results of their disinterested efforts, serving as they do without compensation, must call for some measure of notice and commendation.

In the appended list of vouchers issued to the employes, and for the current bills of expense for supplies, is shown the expenditure for maintenance of the Capitol; and the annexed statements of account with the Auditor and Treasurer are submitted in verification thereof. It will be noted, in this connection, that at the close of the last fiscal year there was a deficit of \$6,061.57 in the maintenance fund, a result that has been perennial for the past twelve years. This condition is owing to several causes, all unavoidable, and which could not be, at least were not, anticipated when the appropriations were made. Many improvements that were absolutely necessary to the conservation of the build-

ing and its surroundings were not provided for, and the Board assumed the responsibility, trusting to the civic pride and liberality of the Assembly to indorse their action. It is earnestly hoped that the incoming Legislature will be considerate of such contingencies in making appropriation for the ensuing term of two years. It is impossible, with the greatest care and foresight, and with years of experience, to *exactly* estimate what will be needed and, therefore, appropriations should be such as to provide for such contingencies as have invariably arisen in the past. In the event of an excess, the balance remaining unexpended would revert to the General Fund.

Referring to the improvements above mentioned that have called for expenditures which were not provided for, but that the Board deemed not only proper, but necessary, there may be mentioned the following:

A great addition to the general expense of maintenance has also been caused by the needs of the numerous new boards and commissions created by the last Legislature, notably:

The Railroad Commission,
The Bank Commission,
The Public Accountant,
The Civil Service Commission,
The Pure Food Commission,
The Insurance Commission.

ADDITIONAL ROOMS NEEDED.

The various Boards named above have, for the past two years, been occupying rooms which appertain to, and will be needed by, the Assembly for their various committees, and space will have to be provided somewhere for the officers and their assistants. The large room formerly used by the Court of Appeals has been utilized by dividing it into three offices which will be assigned to the following departments, viz.:

Railroad Commission,
Bank Commission,
Fish and Game Commission.

To accommodate the remainder of the occupants of committee rooms there will be required some twenty-two more offices,

and owing to the fact that every available foot of space in the building is in use at the present time, it is apparent that some provision must be made for the accommodation of the offices enumerated, as follows:

Public Accountant,
Inspector of Building and Loan Associations,
Pure Food Inspector,
Civil Service Commission,
Insurance Commission,
Bureau of Vital Statistics,
Bureau of Child and Animal Protection,
Dairy Commission,
Colorado Prison Association,
Water Commissioner,
Oil Inspector,
Printing Commissioner.

In order to properly accommodate these officers an addition to the east wing of the Capitol has been suggested as the only way out of the dilemma, and at the last meeting of the Board the Supervising Architect submitted plans and specifications and an estimate of the cost of such addition, all of which will be laid before your Honorable Body.

BOILERS.

It is suggested by the Engineer, that while the boilers used in the building are in fairly good condition, yet owing to their long service it might be well to provide for putting in new ones within the next two years. These boilers are now insured for \$20,000.00 in the Hartford Boiler Inspection and Insurance Company.

During the past two years new furnishings have been bought and allotted as follows:

New carpets for the Senate and House of Representatives; these are of the best Wilton velvet.

Chief Justice Steele's room newly carpeted.

New carpets for two committee rooms.

New carpet and linoleum for the Attorney General's rooms.

New carpets in the office of the Secretary of State.

New carpets for the Superintendent of Public Instruction.

New carpets in the Coal Mine Inspector's office.

New carpets in the office of the Adjutant General.

All of the latter being body Brussels.

Carpets have been cleaned and relaid in the following offices:

Insurance Commissioner,
State Boiler Inspector,
Board of Capitol Managers, and
Secretary of State.

Sectional book-cases have been provided for the use of the several justices of the Supreme Court.

All fittings of wood in the vaults have been removed and replaced by shelves and files of metal.

All of the old carpets which were not worn out have been taken up, carefully cleaned and relaid.

All furniture in the Capitol has been thoroughly renovated, including the washing and varnishing of the desks in the Assembly Rooms. This work has been well and carefully done by the regular cabinetmaker in the building.

Each desk in the Senate and House is now supplied with an electric call bell communicating with an annunciator in the rooms set apart for the Pages.

All of the improvements authorized by the last Assembly have been completed in a thorough and workmanlike manner, and in every case a good and sufficient indemnifying bond has been required from contractors, and is on file.

FIRE INSURANCE.

No insurance has ever been carried on the building and furniture since its occupancy. Frequent recommendations were made to this end during the term ending November 30th, 1906, but no action was taken. While the material used in the construction of the Capitol dispels danger of a disastrous conflagration, yet the vast amount of combustible material and the woodwork, the furniture and carpets, the framework of the roof of the building, and the records stored in the various rooms set apart for that purpose have impelled the Board to guard against accident. A small fire in one of the Supreme Court rooms, caused by the throwing of a match into a waste-basket, destroyed curtains, woodwork and carpet amounting to \$96.00. Had not the janitor discovered this fire at a late hour in the evening, the destruction might have amounted to thousands of dollars. To guard against loss from such accidents the Board at its regular meeting March 4, 1908, adopted a resolution authorizing insurance of \$275,000.00 on the building and furniture for five years.

In this connection extraordinary precautions have been taken by the installing of fire extinguishers, of the latest patents, on every floor; and hose, in one hundred feet lengths (four hundred feet on each floor), is provided. The watchmen and janitors have been instructed in the use of these articles by the clerk and the head janitor, and abundant water is always available.

WIRING SYSTEM.

As an extra precaution the wiring system has been carefully overhauled and every part of it so enclosed, by the electrician, that there is scarcely a possibility of accident from that source—except in sub-basement, which will be provided for as soon as funds are available.

IMPROVEMENTS ON AND AROUND THE CAPITOL.

Referring to the improvements ordered by the Sixteenth General Assembly, it will be noted that every part of this work has been faithfully done, for less than the amount estimated. The laying of the sidewalk (of cement) around the grounds speaks for itself. The roof of the Building, which was beginning to leak, has been entirely repaired, and is of such construction that there will be no further fear of leakage while the Building stands.

ARTESIAN WELL.

The well was finished and accepted in April, 1908; the depth is eight hundred feet. Body of water rises to within 200 feet of surface. The supply is ample for the uses of the Capitol and grounds, but has only been used thus far for the Building. By providing storage tanks the irrigation of the grounds can be accomplished, involving a saving of two thousand dollars per annum. The analysis of the water is herewith submitted, showing that it is practically pure and soft in character:

DOME.

The painting of the iron work of the dome and the gilding has been done within the minimum of the expense authorized; including the electric lantern surmounting the dome, the cost has been less than one-half of what was contemplated. The globe is four feet in diameter, and the lamps are of 1,440 candle power. While much criticism has been indulged in concerning this adornment, by so-called artists and censors of public works, the fact exists that "a thing of beauty is a joy forever," and the thousands of visitors to Denver unanimously admire and commend this em-

bellishment of a structure which is the pride of every loyal Coloradoan. The globe itself completes the symmetry of the Building and the illumination from the electric lamps is at once unique and a constant attraction at night.

Radiator shields for protection of the walls have been placed in all rooms where needed.

A freight elevator has been installed, and has been in use between the basement and sub-basement for the past year.

The vacuum cleaning plant has been in use for a year and has given perfect satisfaction.

APPENDIX

A BILL

FOR

An Act Making an Appropriation for the Payment of a Part of the Expenses for the Maintenance and Support of the Capitol Building and Grounds.

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in what is known as the "Capitol Building Fund," and not otherwise appropriated, the sum of seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) to pay a part of the maintenance and support of the State Capitol Building and grounds of the State of Colorado, for the furnishing of fuel, light, water, telephone service, supplies for Legislature and State officers, engine and boiler supplies, wages of engineers, firemen, watchmen, janitors, elevator pilots and other necessary expenses.

Sec. 2. The certificates of indebtedness issued in payment thereof shall bear interest at the rate of five (5) per cent per annum, from the date of presentation to the date of payment thereof.

Sec. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists with regard to matters provided for in this bill and, therefore, this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved February 4, 1907.

A BILL

FOR

An Act Making Appropriations for the Maintenance and Support of the State Capitol Building and the Grounds Surrounding and Belonging Thereto, for the Years 1907 and 1908, and for Replacing Old Furniture and Carpets, and Supplying New Furniture in the Various Departments of the Capitol Building, When Required.

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. For the maintenance and support of the State Capitol Building, and grounds, of the State of Colorado, for the furnishing of fuel, light, water, telephone service, necessary supplies for the Legislature and State officers, for engine, boilers, elevator and electrical supplies, repairs, office expenses, pay of secretary and clerk, electrician, guides, watchmen, engineers, firemen, elevator pilots, janitors and janitors' supplies, foreman and laborers on grounds, etc., for the years 1907 and 1908, there is hereby appropriated out of the Capitol Building Fund the sum of sixty-eight thousand dollars (\$68,000), or so much as may be necessary.

Sec. 2. For the purpose of replacing old furniture and carpets, and supplying new furniture when required in the various departments, there is hereby appropriated out of the Capitol Building Fund the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, and for which no funds have been appropriated since 1905.

Sec. 3. The Auditor of State is hereby authorized, and directed, to issue certificates of indebtedness for all claims duly audited and certified by the Board of Capitol Managers for material furnished and labor performed when there are no funds in the Treasury at the time of the issuance thereof to meet the same. Said certificates of indebtedness to be payable out of the Capitol Building Fund, and out of the moneys appropriated for the maintenance and support of said Capitol Building and grounds. The faith and credit of the State of Colorado are hereby pledged for the payment of interest and principal of this indebtedness; and it is further provided that the said certificates of indebtedness shall be presented to the State Treasurer, who shall, thereupon, countersign and indorse the same, as bearing interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually from the date of presentation to the date of payment thereof; but in no event shall the certificates be in excess of the appropriations made for the maintenance.

Sec. 4. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists; therefore this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.

Approved April 9, 1907.

A BILL

FOR

An Act Making Appropriation for the Completion of the Capitol Building; for Necessary Improvements in the Building and on the Surrounding Grounds.

Be it Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the Treasury, being funds collected by levy or otherwise for the completion of the State Capitol; and from such other funds as make part of what is known as the "Capitol Building Fund," and not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ninety-one thousand nine hundred and forty and thirty-seven one-hundredths dollars (\$91,940.37), or so much as may be necessary, as follows:

For a statue for the dome.

For painting all metal, from roof line to dome, and for metal floor for upper story of dome.

For paving walks adjoining Capitol grounds, viz.: On Colfax avenue, Broadway, 14th avenue and Grant avenue with cement paving, 181,500 superficial feet.

For shields for all radiators throughout the Building.

For Pullman automatic ventilators for all windows in the Building.

For freight elevator, from basement to sub-basement.

For changing steps on the south entrance of Building on 14th avenue.

For vacuum plant, for cleaning walls and carpets in Building.

For repairing the roof valleys and putting the entire roof in good and safe condition.

For renewing the electric wires in the grounds of the Capitol.

For an artesian well to irrigate the lawns and furnish water for the Capitol Building.

For replacing the red sandstone steps on the grounds of the Capitol with granite steps to match the other entrance.

For insuring the Building and furniture for \$500,000 for four years.

For balance due the city and county of Denver for street paving.

Sec. 2. The Auditor of State is hereby authorized and directed to issue certificates of indebtedness for all claims duly audited and certified by the Board of Capitol Managers for material furnished and labor performed in and about the completion and improvements of said Building; when there are no

funds in the Treasury at the time of the issuance thereof, to meet the same, said certificates of indebtedness to be payable out of the Capitol Building Fund, and out of the moneys appropriated for the completion and improvements of said Capitol Building. The faith and credit of the State of Colorado are hereby pledged for the payment of interest and principal of this indebtedness; and it is further provided that the said certificates of indebtedness shall be presented to the State Treasurer, who shall thereupon countersign and indorse the same as bearing interest at the rate of five per cent (5%) per annum, from the date of presentation to the date of payment thereof; but in no event shall the certificates be in excess of the appropriations made for the completion and improvements of said Building.

Sec. 3. On the tenth day of each and every month, if there be funds in the Treasury to pay any certificates of indebtedness provided for in the foregoing section, the Treasurer of State is hereby required and directed to give notice, by advertisement in a newspaper published in the city of Denver, designating the certificates by number, in order of their presentation to the State Treasurer, and indorse thereon which the funds in the Treasury will pay. At the end of thirty days from the date of the last insertion interest on the certificate so named, as being payable, shall cease.

Sec. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. In the opinion of the General Assembly an emergency exists with regard to the matters provided for in this bill, and therefore this act shall take effect, and be in force, from and after its passage.
